The RST Department of Natural Resources & Game, Fish and Parks would like to invite all interested locals to attend a Hunter-Safety Course. This certification is required for all youth, **ages 12-17**, whom wish to hunt with a RST Tribal hunting license. However, the class can be taken by anyone 12 years old or older. If a youth hunter turns 12 before the end of 2018, they may also participate in the course.

The 2-day course will be held in Mission, SD at the new, temporary Game, Fish and Parks office (old Credit Program building) on **Saturday, April 7<sup>th</sup>, from 9AM-4PM and on Sunday, April 8<sup>th</sup>, from 9AM – 4PM.** The participant must attend **both** days of training in order to successfully complete the class. Along with their hunter-safety certification, they will also get hands-on training on proper handling of a firearm. If the participant passes the required test, they will also be taken to the firing range in Rosebud, SD for some practice with live ammunition.

We ask that a parent or guardian accompany their child to the first session, as we need some personal information that your child may not know. There is also a waiver form that needs to be signed by a parent/guardian (if under 18). If you plan on sending your child with another adult, please make sure they know their personal info (i.e. DOB, SSN, address, etc) and that you have signed the parent waiver.
